Objective:

- 2. To explore the safety measures and security systems in place to ensure smooth and safe airport functioning .
- 3. The students will observe how airport management coordinates with airlines, ground handling services, and other stakeholders to ensure efficiency.
- 4. The students will gain familiarity with various ground handling services, baggage handling & aircraft

Description:

SCM AND General Management (Department), Chitkara Business School, organised a 2-day Industrial Visit to 'Chandigarh International Airport Limited', also known as Shaheed Bhagat Singh Airport on September 5 and 6, 2024 for BBA Aviation Management students in the 2023 batch. Faculty Coordinators, Dr. Nayhel Sharma and Dr. Monika Gupta accompanied the students during the visit. The Executive Officer of Airport Operations, provided an in-depth understanding of the various facets that keep an airport running smoothly. The visit started with an overview of the baggage checking process, where students learned how passenger luggage is meticulously screened and handled to ensure safety and efficiency. They were also taken through the procedures for both international and domestic flight takeoffs, observing the precision required at each stage. Exploring the apron area, the learners saw the aircraft up close, including the impressive hangars and MRO (Maintenance, Repair, and Overhaul) facilities that ensure the safety and reliability of every flight. The day was also filled with excitement as the students witnessed live takeoffs of an IndiGo A320 and an ATR aircraft and military helicopter. The power and precision of these machines were awe-inspiring. One of the highlights was learning about the DigiYatra check-in system, which is revolutionizing passenger experiences by making the process faster and more seamless. The students also gained insight into the handling of restricted items

Outcomes:

- 1. The students gained firsthand experience of the complexities involved in managing a major airport.
- 2. The students understood the significance of safety and security in aviation and how protocols are implemented in real time.
