- **In text referencing:** References are listed in **numerical order** and in the same order in which they are cited in text. The reference list appears at the end of the paper. Use Arabic numerals (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9). One can use [], () or superscript.

**For eg.** However, Biswas M [2] has stated that the use of newer methods may help to keep a check on this increasing population.

- **Reference Section:** For articles with 1 to 6 authors, list all authors. For articles with more than 6 authors, list the first 6 authors then add 'et al.' The digital object identifier (DOI) is a unique identifier, and should be provided in the reference where it is available.
