

## References (Pharmaceutical Track)

Reference should be cited in the text by author's last name & year.

Single author: the author's name (without initials) and the year of publication eg. (Martin, 2009).

Two authors: Last name of both the authors and year of publication should be used i.e. (Mishra and Ahmed, 2010). Three or more authors: first author's name followed by et al and year of publication i.e. (Das *et al.*, 2012).

References should be arranged in alphabetical order and further shorted in chronological manner.
