PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- This program is jointly developed by mapping Chitkara University, Bachelor of Business Administration to the curriculum
 of BBA degree at Trent University, Canada so that the students can seamlessly transfer with credit for recognition of prior
 learning and receive the same learning outcomes and a globally recognised degree i.e. Bachelor of Business
 Administration from Trent University, Canada.
- Apart from saving hugely on international tuition fee when you study for 2 years at Chitkara University, a high school student will also learn an applied Canadian pedagogy when they start closer to home before opting to transfer after two years to Trent University in Canada. Besides tuition fees, a student will also save on-boarding and lodging costs when they stay in their home country for the first two years.
- A conditional offer letter from TrentU is issued to all students at the start of the course that lays down the conditions to transfer to Trent University in Canada after successfully completing two years of their study at Chitkara University.
- Students would be coached for the English Language Proficiency requirement (IELTS) during the first two years of studies at Chitkara University.

Trent University has two campus locations – Peterborough, Ontario and the Durham GTA campus in Oshawa, Ontario. Specialisation options may vary depending on campus location and the primary campus that a student intends to study at will be determined upon application to Trent University.

The specialisations are offered as follows:

- Specialisation in Marketing and Consumer Culture: offered at both the Peterborough and Durham campus
- Specialisation in Human Resource Management: offered at both the Peterborough and Durham campus
- Specialisation in Entrepreneurship: offered at both the Peterborough and Durham campus
- Specialisation in Information Systems and e-Commerce: offered at both the Peterborough & Durham campus
- Specialisation in Finance: offered only at the Peterborough campus

Trent University gets you career ready by offering lots of hands-on learning experiences, practicums, exchanges, labs, and community service learning opportunities.

Depending on the graduate's focus and level of experience, possible career opportunities are:



TRANSFER TO CANADA

You have an option to apply for transfer to Trent University in Canada after studying and demonstrating academic success (with a min requisite of 7 CGPA on a scale of 10) and other statutory requirements while studying two years of Bachelor of Business Administration at Chitkara University. You will be eligible to transfer into the third year of BBA with specialisation degree at Trent University with all transfer credits of prior learning from the first two years of your study at Chitkara University. Here you will spend another two years of study to get a 4-Year BBA degree from Trent University. You will also be eligible to apply for a three year post study work permit after successful completion of your program.

However, apart from demonstrating academic success in the first two years at Chitkara University, you have to secure a study permit from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC), the only Canadian government visa granting authority.

Other conditions include but are not limited to:

- Valid IELTS Score of 6.5 cumulative with no band lower than 6.0
- No prior refusal of any visa for Canada on your passport
- Have demonstrated academic success while studying first two years of your bachelor degree education at Chitkara University and secured minimum CGPA.

Please note that IRCC has the sole right to grant or refuse any kind of visa to Canada and no external factor or entity has any say, control or influence on their decision.
