## INTRODUCTION

Nautical Studies deals with navigation, cargo operations, maintenance of ship and all legal and commercial matters pertaining to shipping business. Deck officers look after the Safety related to lifesaving and fire fighting. They participate in navigating the vessel across the oceans and along the coast. In port all cargo operations are either undertaken by them or conducted under their direct supervision. The Captain of the ship is the ultimate authority and responsible for maintaining the administration onboard. He is also the custodian of the cargo which is carried on his ship, thus making him liable for all legal & commercial matters.


Ships have always been the most efficient mode of transporting goods. This fact has not changed over the centuries even though technology has made enormous strides. In fact, the maritime industry has effectively harnessed technology to become

increasingly more efficient and thereby sustain its comparative advantage over other forms of transport. The growth of global trade has led to a commensurate growth in the world fleet to well over 50,000 ships plying the world's oceans today.

A Deck Officer aboard a ship needs to function in the selfcontained environment of a ship at sea and must also demonstrate additional skills such as fire fighting and damage control, boathandling and the ability to carry out rescue operations in an

emergency. Further, ships are required to remain in operation 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. All this makes the Deck Officer's job extremely challenging and demanding. At the same time the opportunity to travel the world, work with global organizations and experience varied technologies make navigation and ship handling an exciting career.

## CAREER PATH AS NAUTICAL SCIENCE

Opportunity to work as a Deck Cadet on Merchant Ship of Indian or Foreign companies after completing the course. On completion of the stipulated periods on the ship and passing Competency Examinations conducted by Directorate General of shipping, Ministry of Shipping, Government of India, Deck Cadet eventually becomes eligible to be posted as Captain of a Ship.

- As Deck Cadet -3 Years Degree (Nautical Science)+ Five Basic STCW modular courses
- Third Officer/ Second Officer Specified sea service as a Deck Cadet+ 2nd Mate (FG) Certification
- Chief Officer Specified sea service + First Mate (FG) course + Modular Courses + 1st Mate (FG) Certification
- Master (Captain) Specified sea service + 1 month ASM Course + Master (FG) certification.

After completion of the course, Students will be placed for ON-BOARD training as per DG Shipping norms, making them eligible to give competency exam for their promotions.

## ELIGIBILITY

- Pass in 12th Standard or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and English as separate subjects with a PCM average of not less than 60%.
- 60% in 12th standard with Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics.
- Medical Fitness: As per Directorate General of Shipping (DGS) Norms
- Eyesight: No color blindness, Unaided 6/6 vision in both eyes
- Age Limit: 23
- Qualified in IMU CET
- Passport is mandatory to process INDoS
- All Applicants will undergo an entrance test of Chitkara University School of Maritime Studies. This test comprises of MCQ type Questions on Maths, Physics, Chemistry, English and General Aptitude covering syllabus of Class Xth to XIIth, similar to IMU CET.

#### Approved by Directorate General of Shipping, Government of India. (MTI NO. 106025)

The six months General Purpose Rating (GP Rating) Course is approved by the Directorate General of Shipping (Government of India). This course includes a broad range of practical, workshop and lab skills, using state-of-the-art instrumentation and on-board training.

The subject areas addressed include but are not limited to: English, Personality and Communication Skills, Health Hazards & Personal Safety, Usage of Life Saving Appliances & Fire Fighting Appliances, Safe Working Practices on Deck & in Engine Room, First Aid, Security at Sea, Engine Room Watch Keeping, Navigation & Watch Keeping, Ship's Maintenance, Cargo Handling and Stowage and Basic Environmental Protection.

The curriculum is a blend of theory and practical training along with skills like parade, swimming, sports, workshop training, rope and mast climbing, life-saving, firefighting exercises and ship visit. This course ensures higher employability of the Indian seafarers in the international market.

#### **COURSE HIGHLIGHTS**

The course follows the curriculum as laid down by DG shipping in compliance with the STCW Course as promulgated by IMO. The curriculum besides essentially covering the academic knowledge lays stress on hands-on training for skill development.

GP Rating is a six months residential course as per the DG Shipping norms, requiring all the trainees to reside inhouse. The course will cover all aspects of the seafaring profession (Deck and Engine). It also includes the basic STCW courses.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- The candidate must have scored an aggregate 40% in 10th standard with Science and Mathematics as compulsory subjects from a recognized board.
- The candidate must have scored an aggregate 40% in English in 10th standard from a recognized board.
- The minimum age limit for this course is 18 and the maximum age limit for this course is 25 years.

OR

- The candidate must have passed 2 years ITI course from a govt. recognized institute with a minimum aggregate 50% in the final year.
- The candidate must have secured a minimum aggregate 40% in English.

OR

- A candidate who is a Diploma or Degree holder and the degree must be recognized by any State/Central Government or the AICTE.
- The maximum age limit for the degree or diploma is raised to 27 years, with a condition that they are candidates are provided with shipboard training within one year of completion of the course.
- Medical Fitness as per the DGS norms.
- Please note that passport is mandatory to process INDoS.

#### CAREER OPTIONS AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE COURSE

After the successful completion of the six months General Purpose Rating course, there is a wide range of job prospects and opportunities available. GP Rating candidates have been trained in both Deck and Engine Room duties. Depending on the demands of the organization, such ratings may be used in the deck department and/or the engine department. They are responsible for tasks such as seamanship, cargo handling, deck maintenance and machinery operation & maintenance.

The Indian seafarers' employability in the global market has improved as a result of this course.

Students who successfully pass the examination (BES) are issued INDIAN CDC and are eligible for ship jobs around the world. The students can join a ship as:

- Trainee OS (Ordinary Seaman)
- Trainee Fitter
- Trainee Oiler
- Trainee Engine Room Cadet (for Diploma holders)

Based on their performance and sea service, they can be promoted to, Able-Bodied Seamen / Motor Man.

They can also aspire to become Officers after attaining the required sea service and obtaining CoC.
