Additionally, the school has a well-equipped fire mock-up area to train cadets in handling emergencies (FFPF), workshop facilities, a seamanship lab, and a marine workshop with elementary first aid (EFA) equipment. There is also an innovation center that provides a hands-on learning environment for students.

SIMULATOR

Our world-class bridge simulator is essential for the practical, hands-on development of skills in a real navigation environment. It provides work-worthy conditions, allowing for coordination between the ship master, pilot, tug master, and vessel traffic services. This tool is crucial for operational safety and reliability studies of ship maneuvering, as well as for the training and assessment of mariners.




LIBRARY FACILITIES

CUSMS has a spacious library with a reading hall, group discussion area, and online browsing facilities. It houses around 1200 items in various formats including books, journals, and multimedia materials. The library also offers access to over 10,000 electronic journals and daily newspapers. Skilled staff are available to assist students in finding information on marine topics.

The School offers spacious, amphitheater-style classrooms with advanced equipment, including overhead projectors, black/white smart boards, maps, and models to create a conducive environment for dynamic discussions, lectures, and presentations. B.Sc in Nautical Science

B.Sc Nautical Science is a three-year undergraduate program that is designed to train and prepare students for a career in the merchant navy. The program covers a wide range of subjects such as mathematics, physics, marine engineering, navigation, and ship operation.

The course curriculum also includes practical training, which is mandatory for all students. During this training, students are required to spend a certain amount of time on board a ship, where they learn about various aspects of ship operation and navigation.

Eligibility:

Passed 12th standard examination with a minimum of 60% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics. Also, the candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the English language in 10th or 12th standard.

Modular Courses in Basic Safety Training

Chitkara University's modular courses in Basic Safety Training for Seafarers is a specialised training program designed to provide fundamental safety training in the maritime industry. The course is designed to comply with the requirements of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watch keeping for Seafarers (STCW), and is of 12-day duration, split into the following modules:

- Personal Safety and Social Responsibility | Duration 4 days
- Fire Prevention and Firefighting | Duration 3 days
- Elementary First Aid | Duration 2.5 days
- Personal Survival Techniques | Duration 2.5 days

Eligibility:

Candidates interested in BST Modular Courses at Chitkara University must have basic literacy and numeracy skills, besides fulfilling the medical fitness criteria as laid down by the governing body. Generally, the courses are meant for candidates interested in a seafaring career.

INDOS No and Passport is mandatory.





Career Opportunities

Completing a modular course in basic safety training in the merchant navy can provide individuals with a solid foundation of knowledge and skills to work safely in the shipping industry. This can open up various career opportunities in different roles and positions within the industry.

Security Training for Seafarers with Designated Security Duties (STSDSD)

Chitkara University School of Maritime Studies' STSDSD program is a specialised training course work designed to provide fundamental security training to seafarers who work on-board ships. The training program is designed to comply with the requirements of the International Maritime Organisation's (IMO) International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code.

The program on Security Training for Seafarers covers the following topics:

- Security Awareness
- Security Responsibilities
- Ship Security Assessment
- Anti-Piracy Measures
- Cyber Security

Completing a program on security training for seafarers assuredly enhances the safety and security of the ship and its crew, and can also improve the employability of seafarers by meeting the industry's regulatory requirements for security training.



Certificate Course in Maritime Catering

Chitkara University School of Maritime Studies' Certificate Course in Maritime Catering is a vocational training program designed to provide candidates with the skills and knowledge required to work as a catering crew member on board ships. The course curriculum covers various aspects of maritime catering, such as food safety, nutrition, menu planning, food production, and galley management.

Course Duration - 6 Months

Eligibility:

Passed Class 10th from any stream with 50% marks. In 10th & 12th standard 40% marks in English.

Either at 10th or 12th standard after completing the Certificate Course in Maritime Catering, candidates can work in various roles on board ships such as a chef, cook, or steward.



General Purpose Rating Course

Chitkara University School of Maritime Studies' General Purpose Rating Course is a pre-sea training program for individuals who wish to work in the deck or engine department of a ship at the support level. The course is approved by the Directorate General of Shipping (DGS).

The GP Rating is a 6-month course and covers various topics related to the maritime industry.

ELIGIBILITY

• Age:

Candidates must be at least 17.5 years old and not more than 25 years old at the time of admission.

• Educational Qualifications:

Candidates must have passed the 10th standard examination from a recognized board with a minimum of 50% marks in English, Mathematics and Science.

• Medical Fitness:

Candidates must be medically fit as per the standards set by the DGS.

• Language Proficiency:

Candidates must be proficient in English, as the course is conducted in English.
